INTRODUCTION

The data presented here are based on the results of the provincewide *Reliance Survey of Vocational Training at the Secondary Level*, conducted annually by the Ministère de l'Éducation, du Loisir et du Sport (MELS). The survey carried out in 2008 concerns the graduating class of 2006-2007. The surveys carried out in 2007 and 2006 concerned the graduating classes of 2005-2006 and 2004-2005, respectively.

The purpose of this survey is to provide an accurate picture of the situation of graduates from secondary-level vocational training programs approximately nine months after they have earned a diploma. It meets a need for accurate, relevant information on how well recent graduates are faring on the labour market, just as the other two *Reliance* surveys do in the case of college and university graduates.

HIGHLIGHTS

The **highlights** from the 2008 survey (describing the situation as of March 31, 2008) are as follows:

- About nine months after graduates obtained a diploma in vocational training, the employment rate for those who earned a Diploma of Vocational Studies (DVS) was 77.8%, while for those who earned an Attestation of Vocational Specialization (AVS) it was 73.0%.
- In 2008, the unemployment rate for DVS graduates was 9.6%. This is the lowest unemployment rate in the past 10 years. For AVS graduates, the unemployment rate in 2008 was 9.4%, compared with 9.8% in 2006.
- Among graduates who were employed, 88.6% were working full-time (30 or more hours per week) after receiving their DVS, while the corresponding rate for those with an AVS was 86.5%. For DVS graduates, this rate has fluctuated little and has remained above 85.0% for the past several years.
- The percentage of DVS graduates working full-time was 94.4% for men and 80.9% for women. The corresponding percentage of AVS graduates working full-time was 93.2% for men and 79.8% for women.
- Among DVS graduates with full-time jobs, 79.5% said their work was related to their training. The corresponding rate for those with an AVS was 68.3%.
- The average gross weekly salary for DVS graduates working full-time has been rising. In 2008, the average gross weekly salary was \$611, representing a 4.1% increase relative to 2007. For AVS graduates working full-time, the average gross weekly salary in 2008 was \$633, compared with \$605 in 2007, representing an increase of 4.6%.

GLOSSARY OF THE MAIN TERMS USED IN THE TABLES

TARGET GRADUATES

“Target graduates” refers to all holders of a Diploma of Vocational Studies (DVS) or an Attestation of Vocational Specialization (AVS) who graduated during the academic year preceding the survey year.

EMPLOYED

“Employed” refers to target graduates who stated they were self-employed or working for an employer, and not studying full-time.

SEEKING EMPLOYMENT

“Seeking employment” refers to target graduates who stated they were actively looking for a job and were neither studying nor working.

STUDYING

“Studying” refers to target graduates who stated they were either studying full-time or part-time, and not working.

INACTIVE

“Inactive” refers to target graduates who stated they were not employed, were not seeking employment, and were not studying.

UNEMPLOYMENT RATE (UNEMPLOYED)

“Unemployment rate (unemployed)” refers to the number of graduates seeking employment compared with the number of people in the labour force (which includes people who are employed and people who are seeking employment).

WORKING FULL-TIME

“Working full-time” refers to graduates working full-time, i.e. generally 30 hours or more per week.

WORKING PART-TIME

“Working part-time” refers to graduates working part-time, i.e. generally less than 30 hours per week. The proportion of graduates working part-time is obtained by subtracting the proportion of graduates working full-time from 100%.

AVERAGE GROSS WEEKLY SALARY

“Average gross weekly salary” represents the average gross income earned by workers for one week of full-time work. The data reflect only graduates working for an employer.

WORKING IN RELATED FIELD

“Working in related field” refers to graduates working full-time who consider their job to be connected to their field of study.

HOW INDICATORS ARE CALCULATED

The calculation table below uses data from the 2008 *Relance Survey of Vocational Training at the Secondary Level* to illustrate the application of the definitions of the main terms used in the tables.
