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## INTRODUCTION

The data presented here are based on the results of the provincewide *Relance Survey of Vocational Training at the Secondary Level*, conducted annually by the Ministère de l'Éducation, du Loisir et du Sport (MELS). The survey carried out in 2010 concerns the graduating class of 2008-2009. The surveys carried out in 2009 and 2008 concerned the graduating classes of 2007-2008 and 2006-2007, respectively.

The purpose of this survey is to provide an accurate picture of the situation of graduates from secondary-level vocational training programs approximately nine months after they have earned a diploma. It meets a need for accurate, relevant information on how well recent graduates are faring on the labour market, just as the other two *Relance* surveys do in the case of college and university graduates.

## HIGHLIGHTS

Some **highlights** from the 2010 survey (describing the situation as of March 31, 2010):

- On March 31, 2010, approximately nine months after they obtained their diplomas, the employment rate for individuals with a Diploma of Vocational Studies (DVS) was 73.8%, while that of individuals with an Attestation of Vocational Specialization (AVS) was 68.1%. In 2008 and in 2009, the employment rates were 77.8% and 73.5% respectively for those with a DVS and 73.0% and 68.7% for those with an AVS.
- The unemployment rate for DVS graduates remained stable, going from 12.8% in 2009 to 12.5% in 2010. For graduates with an AVS, the unemployment rate rose from 10.9% in 2009 to 12.4% in 2010.
- Among those employed, 87.4% of DVS graduates and 82.3% of graduates with an AVS were working full-time (30 or more hours per week). For DVS graduates, this proportion has remained above 87.0% and has fluctuated little over the past several years.
- For DVS graduates, 93.2% of men were working full-time, compared to 78.8% of women. For graduates with an AVS, the corresponding proportions were 89.3% of men and 76.1% of women.
- Among the DVS graduates working full-time, 76.7% considered their job to be related to their field of study. The corresponding rate for graduates with an AVS is 63.5%.
- The average gross weekly salary for DVS graduates with a full-time job is on the rise. It was \$647 in 2010, an increase of 1.9% over 2009. For graduates with an AVS with full-time jobs, the average gross weekly salary was \$666 in 2009, compared with \$674 in 2010, an increase of 1.2%.

## GLOSSARY OF THE MAIN TERMS USED IN THE TABLES

### TARGET GRADUATES

“Target graduates” refers to all holders of a Diploma of Vocational Studies (DVS) or an Attestation of Vocational Specialization (AVS) who graduated during the academic year preceding the survey year.

### EMPLOYED

“Employed” refers to target graduates who stated they were self-employed or working for an employer, and not studying full-time.

### SEEKING EMPLOYMENT

“Seeking employment” refers to target graduates who stated they were actively looking for a job and were neither studying nor working.

### STUDYING

“Studying” refers to target graduates who stated they were either studying full-time or part-time, and not working.

### INACTIVE

“Inactive” refers to target graduates who stated they were not employed, were not seeking employment, and were not studying.

### **UNEMPLOYMENT RATE (UNEMPLOYED)**

“Unemployment rate (unemployed)” refers to the number of graduates seeking employment compared with the number of people in the labour force (which includes people who are employed and people who are seeking employment).

### **WORKING FULL-TIME**

“Working full-time” refers to graduates working full-time, i.e. generally 30 hours or more per week.

### **WORKING PART-TIME**

“Working part-time” refers to graduates working part-time, i.e. generally less than 30 hours per week. The proportion of graduates working part-time is obtained by subtracting the proportion of graduates working full-time from 100%.

### **AVERAGE GROSS WEEKLY SALARY**

“Average gross weekly salary” represents the average gross income earned by workers for one week of full-time work. The data reflect only graduates working for an employer.

### **WORKING IN RELATED FIELD**

“Working in related field” refers to graduates working full-time who consider their job to be connected to their field of study.

## HOW INDICATORS ARE CALCULATED

The calculation table below uses data from the 2010 *Relance Survey of Vocational Training at the Secondary Level* to illustrate the application of the definitions of the main terms used in the tables.
