INTRODUCTION

This document presents a portrait of all the services and programs of study provided under Adult General Education (AGE). More specifically, it provides complementary information on the *Basic adult general education regulation* (BAGER) and includes schedules with lists of the courses in the Adult General Education programs of study. In addition, boxed texts provide further details about particular sections.

This document is a tool that can be made available to the staff of school boards, adult education centres and regional offices of the Ministère de l'Éducation, du Loisir et du Sport (MELS). Private schools are encouraged to use it for guidance.


1 REFERENCES TO ADULT GENERAL EDUCATION LEGAL AND REGULATORY FRAMEWORKS

Adult General Education educational services are governed by a basic regulation (*Basic adult general education regulation*) established under section 448 of the *Education Act* (EA). They are also linked to the Reception and Referral Services as well as to Recognition of Acquired Competencies Services, both of which are provided for under the *Education Act*. All Québec school boards are authorized to organize educational services for adults for which they may obtain subsidies. Please note that this document does not constitute a legal interpretation of the sections of the *Education Act* and the *Basic adult general education regulation*.

The first basic regulation in the adult sector came into force in 1994.

The specific nature of Adult General Education is confirmed by the fact that the educational services provided under the basic regulation are for individuals who are not legally obligated to attend school.

The following diagram shows the links between the *Education Act* and the *Basic adult general education regulation*.




2 RECEPTION AND REFERRAL SERVICES

(Reference No.: EA, s. 250)

In accordance with the Government Policy on Adult Education and Continuing Education and Training (2002), the reception and referral services were enhanced by the addition of counselling and support services. All of these services are now referred to as SARCA (services d'accueil, de référence, de conseil et d'accompagnement [reception, referral, counselling and support services]).

SARCA services are designed to assist adults, whether enrolled in training or not, in choosing and implementing a learning plan in line with their personal and career goals.

To be more specific, SARCA is an integrated set of services that enable adults to do the following:



School boards are responsible for being proactive and working in partnership with other stakeholders in order to reach the public targeted by the Policy. The funding is provided under the basic allocation included in the 2014-2015 budgetary rules.

Section 250 of the *Education Act* has provided for reception and referral services since 1988.

3 RECOGNITION OF ACQUIRED COMPETENCIES

(Reference No.: EA, s. 250)

Recognition of acquired competencies (RAC) enables adults to obtain official recognition for general-education learning through a process that admits and validates previously acquired learning and competencies and, where applicable, identifies missing components.

Various types of evaluation tests are used for evaluation purposes:

- Adult general education examination (the adult need not have taken the course)
- Spheres of Generic Competencies (related to life experiences)
- Comprehensive examination for Français, langue seconde; Prior Learning Examination (PLE)
- Secondary School Equivalency Tests (SSET)
- General Educational Development Testing Service tests (GEDTS)

Information about these different examinations is provided in the current edition of the *Administrative Guide for the Certification of Studies and Management of Ministerial Examinations: General Education, Youth Sector; General Education, Adult Sector; Vocational Training*.

The allocation for the recognition of acquired competencies is established in accordance with the conditions set forth in the 2014-2015 budgetary rules.

4 EDUCATIONAL SERVICES

(Reference No.: BAGER, s. 1)

Adult General Education educational services are composed of training services (instructional services and orientation services), popular education services and student services. This document deals with training services (items 5, 6 and 7) and student services (item 7).

4.1 Free Educational Services


(Reference No.: EA, s. 3)

Only training services are free. The conditions governing the free access to these services are set forth in BAGER, section 33.

5 INSTRUCTIONAL SERVICES

(Reference No.: BAGER, s. 3)

The following diagram shows the different ways the learning plan can be organized using the various instructional services offered by Adult General Education.



In adult education centres, the learning content provided as part of Literacy Services, Preparatory Services for Secondary Education and Secondary Cycle One Education Services is associated with Common Core Basic Education (CCBE).

The learning content provided as part of Secondary Cycle Two Education Services, Vocational Training Preparation Services and Preparatory Services for Post-Secondary Education are associated with Diversified Basic Education (DBE).

CCBE

The Common Core Basic Education (CCBE) programs of study aim to upgrade the competencies of adult learners, develop their autonomy in exercising their social roles and encourage their self-fulfillment on a personal, intellectual and cultural level.

DBE

The Diversified Basic Education (DBE) programs of study lead to a Secondary School Diploma, vocational training or post-secondary education. Most of these programs are adaptations of the Secondary Cycle Two programs in general education in the youth sector.

Items 5.1 to 5.10 present the educational services and the programs of study associated with each of these services. The courses that compose the programs are listed in Schedules 1 and 2.

Schedule 1 lists all of the courses of the programs of study of the new curriculum that are recorded in the Charlemagne system. School boards and adult education centres are responsible for verifying the availability of examinations before offering a course presented in this Schedule.

5.1 Pedagogical Support Services

(Reference No.: BAGER, s. 4)

The Orientation Services program is intended for any learner enrolled in adult education, regardless of his or her learning path. The program content enables the adult learner to reflect on his or her training objectives, strengths and weaknesses. He or she develops learning strategies and discovers ways to learn how to learn. The program is being updated by MELS.

5.2 Literacy Services

(Reference No.: BAGER, s. 5)

The programs of study in Literacy Services are as follows:

- *English, Language of Instruction; Secondary English for Adult Learners; Français, langue d'enseignement*
- *Mathematics; Computer Science*

The Common Core Basic Education programs of study are being introduced gradually.

5.3 Preparatory Services for Secondary Education

(Reference No.: BAGER, s. 6)

The programs of study in Preparatory Services for Secondary Education are as follows:

- *English Language of Instruction; Secondary English for Adult Learners; English as a Second Language; French as a Second Language; Anglais, langue seconde; Français, langue seconde; Français, langue d'enseignement;*
- *Social and Political Life; Community and Culture; Consumer Habits*
- *Mathematics; Computer Science; Relationship With the Environment; Technology*
- *Introduction to the World of Work; Career Choice*
- *Personal Life and Relationships; Health; Personal and Social Development*

The Common Core Basic Education programs of study are being introduced gradually.

5.4 Secondary Cycle One Education Services (Reference No.: BAGER, s. 7)

The programs of study in Secondary Cycle One Education Services are as follows:

- *English, Language of Instruction; Secondary English for Adult Learners; English as a Second Language; Anglais, langue seconde; French, Second Language; Français, langue d'enseignement; Français, langue seconde; Other Languages*
- *Social and Political Life; Community and Culture; Social Studies*
- *Mathematics; Computer Science; Microcomputing*
- *Personal Life and Relationships; Health; Personal and Social Development; Physical Education*
- *Arts*

The Common Core Basic Education programs of study are being introduced gradually.

5.5 Secondary Cycle Two Education Services (Reference No.: BAGER, s. 8)

The programs of study in Secondary Cycle Two Education Services are also those in Vocational Training Preparation Services and Preparatory Services for Post-Secondary Education. The programs in Secondary Cycle Two Education Services that preceded the introduction of the Common Core Basic Education programs are as follows:

- *Secondary English for Adult Learners; French, Second Language; Français, langue d'enseignement; Français, langue seconde; Anglais, langue seconde; Other Languages*
- *History; Social Studies; Geography; Economics*
- *Mathematics; Microcomputing; Physics; Biology; Chemistry; Physical Science*
- *Personal and Social Development; Physical Education*
- *Arts*

The following Common Core Basic Education programs are being introduced gradually:

- *English Language Arts; English as a Second Language; Anglais, langue seconde; Français, langue seconde; Français, langue d'enseignement*
- *Mathematics; Computer Science; Science and Technology; Chemistry; Physical Science*
- *History and Citizenship Education*; Contemporary World*
- *Personalized Career Orientation*
- *Preventing Dependency on Substances and Gambling; Human Sexuality; Physical Education and Health*

*Note: The courses *Population and Economy* (HIS-4101-2) and *Culture and Power* (HIS-4102-2) in the program of study *History and Citizenship Education* have been withdrawn from the list.

This program is currently being revised in collaboration with the MELS unit responsible for general education in the youth sector.

The new curriculum in Adult General Education requires that special rooms be set up for Science and Technology programs of study in the various adult education centres.

It is possible for a student enrolled in a vocational training program to concurrently acquire general education credits, including credits required to obtain a Secondary School Diploma (SSD). In 2014-2015, the budgetary rules provide for additional funding for this purpose for adults under 20 years of age.

5.6 Social Integration Services (Reference No.: BAGER, s. 9)

- *Social Integration Services*

Social integration services are designed for adults experiencing adjustment difficulties of a psychological, intellectual, social or physical nature.

The Social Integration Services program of study aims to help adults develop a social participation plan and strengthen their autonomy for the purpose of implementing their plan.

5.7 Sociovocational Integration Services (Reference No.: BAGER, s. 10)

- *Sociovocational Integration Services*

The Sociovocational Integration program of study may lead to the Training Certificate in Sociovocational Integration of Adults (TCSIA) or the Training Certificate for a Semiskilled Trade (TCST).

The provisional bridge allowing admission to vocational training is extended until 2015-2016. The admission requirements are as follows: holding a Training Certificate for a Semiskilled Trade (TCST) and successfully completing the Secondary II courses in language of instruction, second language and mathematics.

The programs leading to a Diploma of Vocational Studies (DVS) that are accessible through the provisional bridge are listed in Schedule V of the *Information Document on the Services and Programs of Study Provided Under Vocational Training, 2013-2014*.

5.8 Francization Services (Reference No.: BAGER, s. 11)

- *Français, langue seconde.*

Allophone students enrolled in a French school board take the Français, langue seconde program of study designated by a alphanumeric code starting with "LAN," while adults enrolled in an English school board take the French as a Second Language program of study under one of the FRE codes. This program of study is still in use.

The harmonization of francization training between MELS and the Ministère de l'Immigration, de la Diversité et de l'Inclusion (MIDI) has led to the distribution of the *Échelle québécoise des niveaux de compétence en français des personnes immigrantes adultes* and the *Programme-cadre de français pour les personnes immigrantes adultes au Québec*.

A ministry program of study on francization based on this common reference framework will soon become available.

5.9 Vocational Training Preparation Services (Reference No.: BAGER, s. 12)

Vocational Training Preparation Services enable adults registered in general education to enrol in vocational training during or at the end of their general education.

See the item concerning Secondary Cycle Two Education Services for information on the corresponding programs of study.

5.10 Preparatory Services for Post-Secondary Education (Reference No.: BAGER, s. 13)

Preparatory Services for Post-Secondary Education enable adults enrolled in general education to pursue post-secondary studies during or at the end of their general education, in accordance with the applicable enrolment procedures.

See the item concerning Secondary Cycle Two Education Services for information on the corresponding programs of study.

6 ORIENTATION SERVICES (Reference No.: BAGER, s. 14)

Orientation Services are a continuation of SARCA services.

7 STUDENT SERVICES (Reference BAGER, s. 17-18)

In adult general education, student services aim to help adults to successfully carry out their personal and career plan. A frame of reference on complementary educational services in adult general education was published in 2009.

Student services consist of three programs:

Learning Support Services

These services provide learning conditions that foster the perseverance and academic and career success of adult learners.

Counselling, Promotion and Prevention Services

These services promote the development and maintenance of attitudes and behaviours conducive to every aspect of the adult learners' health and well-being throughout their school careers, during transitions between different training paths and during practicums in the workplace.

Student Life Services

These services provide a stimulating environment that encourages adult learners to become committed to their academic and career plan, their learning environment and their community.

The budgetary rules have provided for specific funding to improve access to student services for all adults in general education. The financing of student services is part of the basic allowance, as set out in the provision *Allocation de base pour les activités éducatives des adultes de la formation générale (sous-section a) enveloppe fermée*.

8 ADMISSION

An individual must be 16 years of age or older as of June 30, 2014, to be considered an adult within the meaning of sections 2 and 14 of the *Education Act*.

An individual under 16 years of age who holds a Training Certificate for a Semiskilled Trade may be admitted to adult general education, in accordance with section 14 of the *Education Act*.

9 EVALUATION OF LEARNING AND CERTIFICATION OF STUDIES

9.1 Evaluation of Learning

(Reference Nos.: BAGER, s. 25 to 29; Info/Sanction10-11-025, 2011-04-13)

The administrative procedures applicable to the evaluation of learning and the certification of studies are described in the current edition of the *Administrative Guide for the Certification of Studies and Management of Ministerial Examinations*, available on the Web site of the MELS Direction de la sanction des études.

9.2 Definitions of the evaluation domain and examinations

The Definition of the Evaluation Domain (DED) ensures consistency between a course and the related evaluation instruments. The DED is used to select, organize and describe the essential and representative elements of the course. The DED is based on the program of study and the course, but should by no means replace them in the planning of instructional activities.

The DEDs produced by the Ministère de l'Éducation, du Loisir et du Sport for Secondary III, IV and V courses and for the francization courses are prescriptive.

Consequently, the DEDs are the reference documents to be used in the development of all examinations, be they ministerial examinations or those developed by adult education centres or by Société GRICS (BIM). The DEDs thus serve as a model for preparing multiple equivalent versions of examinations that are valid across the province.¹

When the Ministère is responsible for producing an examination, it is important to verify with the Direction de la sanction des études that the examination is available before the beginning of the course.

Furthermore, Société GRICS (BIM) also develops definitions of the evaluation domain at the school boards' request. For ethical reasons, only those responsible for developing DEDs may modify their content.

9.3 Certification of Secondary Studies

Section 30 of the *Basic adult general education regulation* describes the applicable certification requirements for obtaining a Secondary School Diploma (SSD).

The results of evaluations to support learning, of diagnostic examinations and of placement tests do not count toward the certification of studies. The Policy on the Evaluation of Learning aims to consolidate and standardize evaluation orientations.

9.4 Official documents issued by the Minister

The Minister issues the following official documents to adults:

- an achievement record that includes the results from secondary school and is printed in accordance with the publication calendar of the Charlemagne system
- an Attestation of Equivalence of Secondary V Studies (AESS), following passage of the Secondary School Equivalency Tests (SSET)
- a Certificate of Equivalence of Secondary Studies (CESS), following passage of the GEDTS tests; a certificate will also be issued by the American Council on Education
- a Secondary School Diploma (SSD)

Upon the recommendation of the school board, the Minister awards the adult the following official documents:

- a Training Certificate in Sociovocational Integration of Adults (TCSIA) (*Info/Sanction 13-14-008, 2013-09-12*)
- a Training Certificate for a Semiskilled Trade (TCST) (*Info/Sanction 13-14-008, 2013-09-12; Info/Sanction 08-09-027, 2009-03-02*)

With regard to the general education component, adults will be required to complete only the practical training if they can demonstrate that they have acquired the competencies for the programs of study in language of instruction and mathematics in Preparatory Services for Secondary education. Adults may demonstrate this by providing an achievement record (report card) or by proving that they have passed examinations for the recognition of prior learning or the evaluation of competencies. This evaluation is based on the sample tasks provided in Schedule 3. These tasks correspond to the level required to practise a semiskilled trade.

Regarding the second language, the centre will verify the prior learning equivalent to 100 hours of training based on an assessment of the experiences described by the adults. This assessment is based on the adults' personal experience, previous formal, non-formal or informal training, or activities carried out in a recreation centre or through a popular education service.

If the adult cannot demonstrate this prior learning, the centre will give the adult the opportunity to acquire this learning (language of instruction, mathematics, second language) concurrently with the practical training. The centre may ensure that the adult has achieved the academic level corresponding to preparatory services for secondary education, without the adult being required to complete 450 hours of general education.

In all cases, the adults will be encouraged to upgrade their level of general education.

- Adults spend the 75 hours devoted to job market preparation in courses in the Sociovocational Integration program. This will help them select a trade, integrate or remain in the work force, or conduct a more effective job search.

- The 375 hours of training leading to a semiskilled trade are completed by means of the three courses related to *Training for a Semiskilled Occupation*. These hours are spent primarily in workplace practicums and lead to mastery of the specific competencies of a semiskilled trade.

9.5 Transmission of Results

School boards shall transmit an adult's results to the Minister upon request and in accordance with the Minister's requirements.

9.6 Duration of Training

(Reference No.: BAGER, s. 31)

The duration of an adult's training is based on the number of credits required to complete his or her Adult General Education learning plan at the rate of 25 hours per credit.

During the training period, an adult is considered to be:

- enrolled on a full-time basis if he or she attends a minimum of 15 hours per week in general education
- enrolled on a part-time basis if he or she does not attend training in the same school board for more than 14 hours per week

However, as part of intensive training activities lasting less than one month, an adult enrolled on a part-time basis may attend training for a maximum of 30 hours per week.

It should be noted that the concepts of full-time and part-time identify the status of the adult student and have no impact on the declaration of enrolment procedure.
