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INTRODUCTION

This document presents a portrait of all the services and Programs of Study provided under Adult General Education (AGE). More specifically, it provides complementary information on the *Basic adult general education regulation* (BAGER) and includes schedules with lists of the courses in the Adult General Education programs of study. In addition, boxed texts provide further details about particular sections.

This document is a tool that can be made available to the staff of school boards, adult education centres and regional offices of the Ministère; private schools are encouraged to use it for guidance.

1 REFERENCES TO CERTAIN ADULT GENERAL EDUCATION LEGAL AND REGULATORY FRAMEWORKS

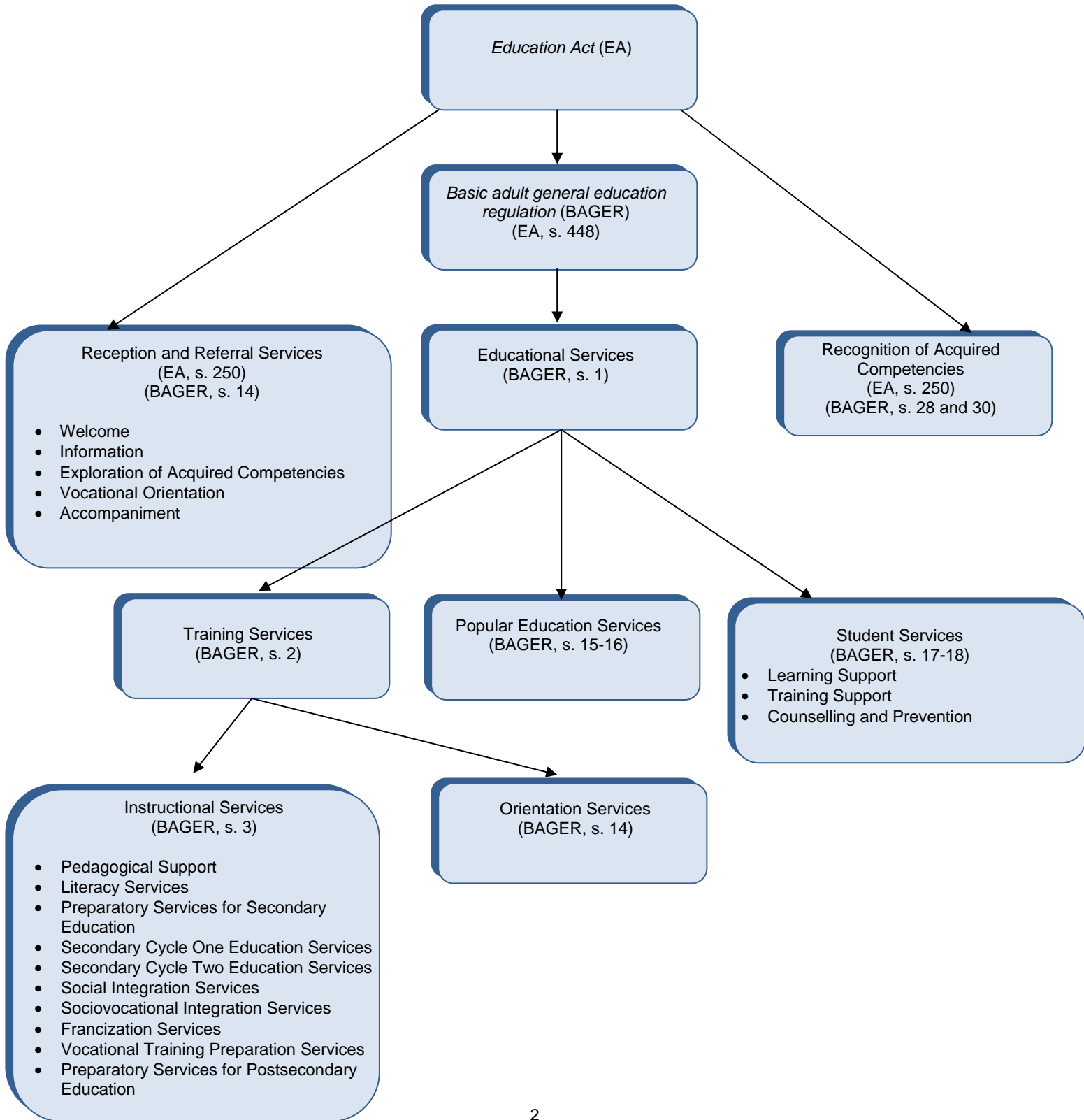
Adult General Education Services are governed by a basic regulation (*Basic adult general education regulation*) established under section 448 of the *Education Act* (EA). They are also linked to the Reception and Referral Services as well as to Recognition of Acquired Competencies Services, both of which are provided for under the *Education Act*. All Québec school boards are authorized to organize educational services for adults for which they may obtain subsidies. Please note that this document does not constitute a legal interpretation of the sections of the *Education Act* and the *Basic adult general education regulation*.

The first basic regulation in the adult sector came into force in 1994.

The very specific nature of Adult General Education is confirmed by the fact that the educational services provided under the basic regulation are for people who are not legally obligated to attend school.

Links between the *Education Act* and the *Basic adult general education regulation*



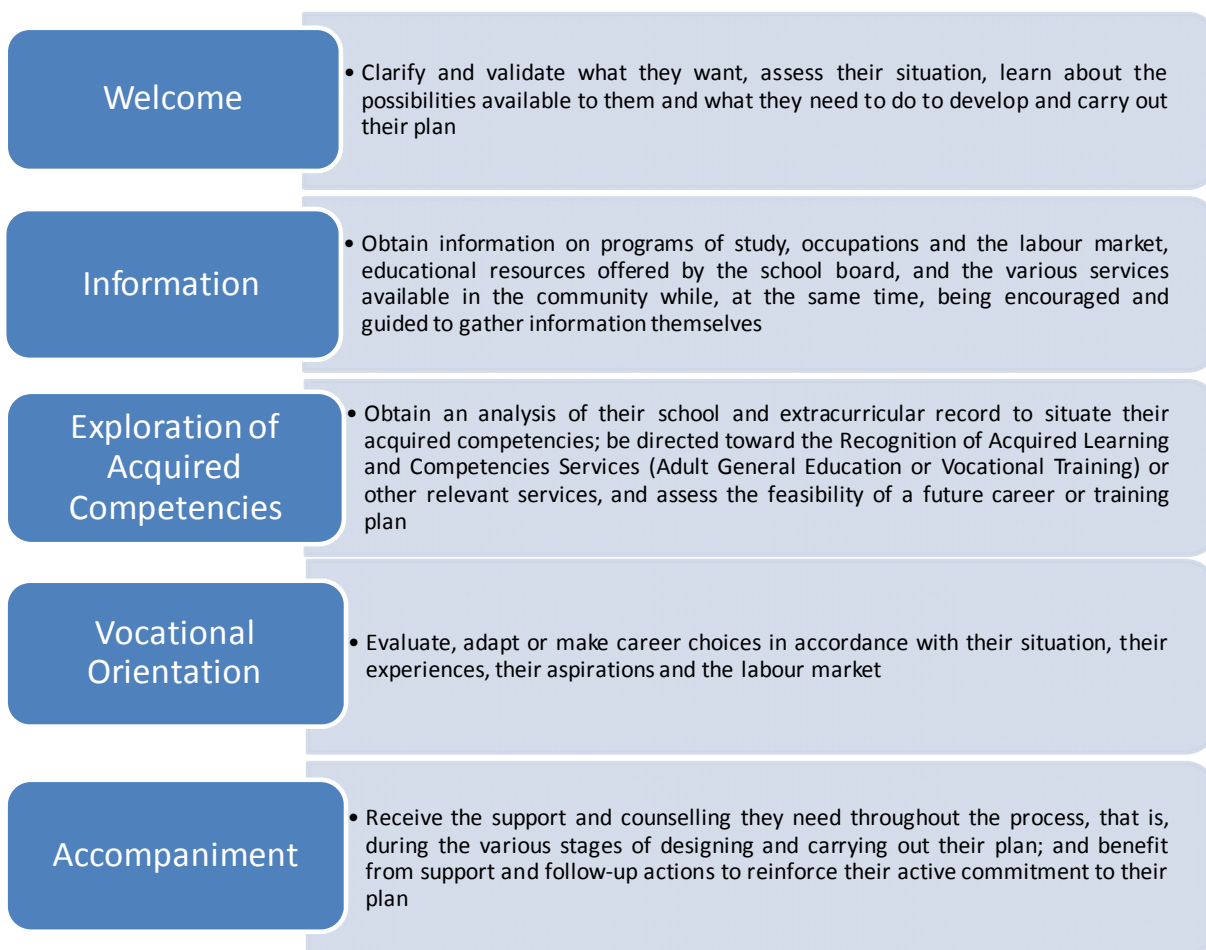
2 RECEPTION AND REFERRAL SERVICES

(Reference No.: EA, s. 250)

In accordance with the *Government Policy on Adult Education and Continuing Education and Training* (2002), the reception and referral services were enhanced by the addition of counselling and support services. All of these services are now referred to as SARCA (services d'accueil, de référence, de conseil et d'accompagnement [reception, referral, counselling and support services]).

SARCA services are designed to assist adults, whether enrolled in training or not, in choosing a learning plan in line with their personal and career goals and in implementing it.

To be more specific, SARCA is an integrated set of services that enable adults to do the following:



School boards are responsible for being proactive and working in partnership in order to reach the public targeted by the Policy. The funding is provided under the basic allocation included in the 2012-2013 budgetary rules.

Section 250 of the *Education Act* has provided for reception and referral services since 1988.

3 RECOGNITION OF ACQUIRED COMPETENCIES

(Reference No.: EA, s. 250)

Recognition of acquired learning and competencies enables adults to have their learning and competencies in general education officially recognized. This process allows previously acquired learning and competencies and, if applicable, missing training components, to be identified.

Various types of evaluation tests are used to recognize acquired competencies in general education: SSET (Secondary School Equivalency Tests); GEDTS (General Educational Development Testing Service tests); Spheres of Generic Competencies (related to life experiences); comprehensive examination for Français, langue seconde; PLE (Prior Learning Examination); right to sit an adult general education examination without having taken the course.

Passing the tests can lead to the recognition of equivalent learning for:

- attestations, diplomas and certificates
- credits that count toward a Secondary School Diploma (SSD)
- credits for prerequisite subjects leading to vocational training and postsecondary studies

The allocation for the recognition of acquired competencies is established in accordance with the conditions set forth in the 2012-2013 budgetary rules.

4 EDUCATIONAL SERVICES

(Reference No.: BAGER, s. 1)

Adult General Education educational services are composed of training services (instructional services and orientation services), popular education services and student services. This document deals with training services (items 5, 6 and 7) and student services (item 7).

4.1 Free Educational Services

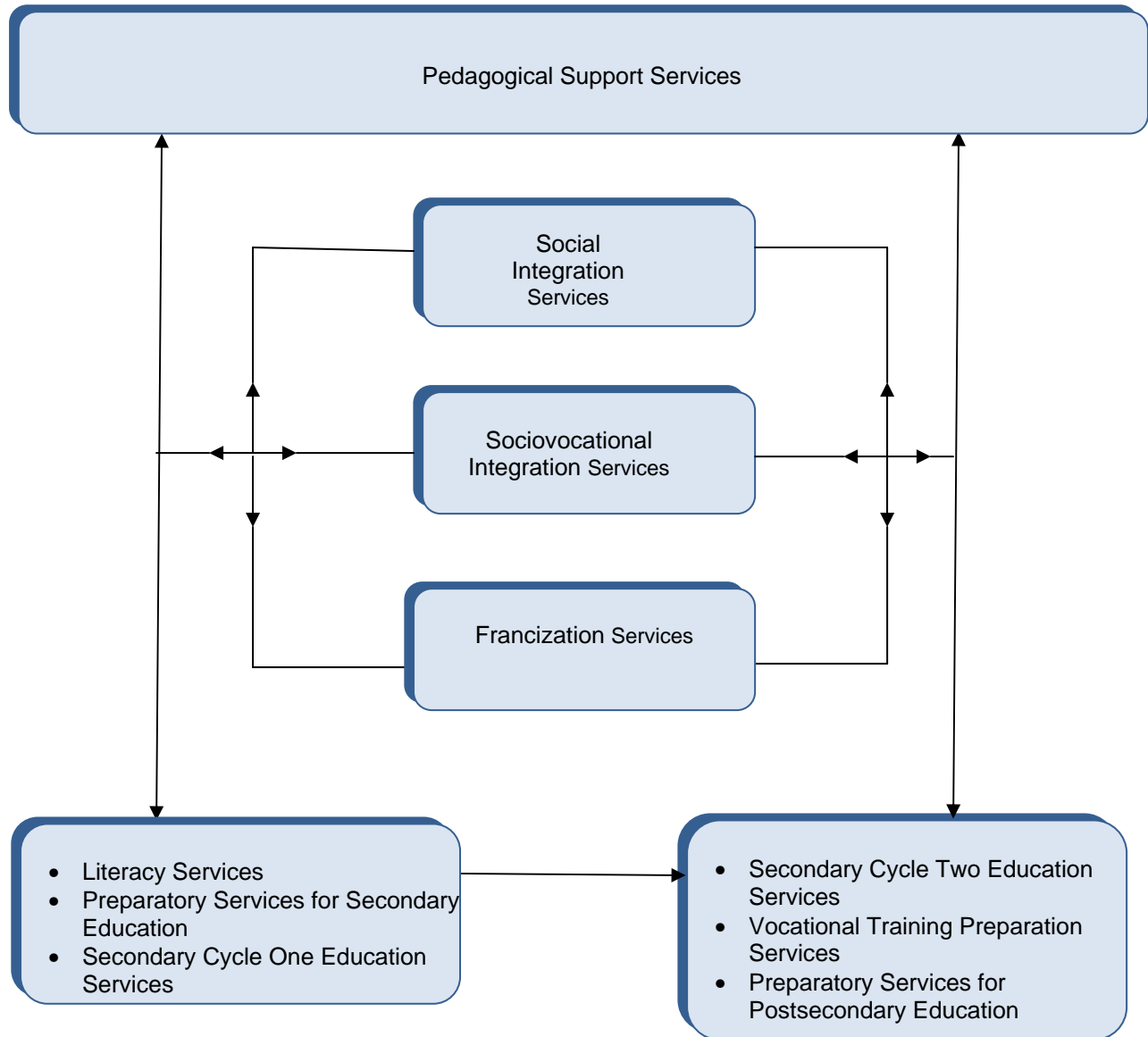
Only training services are free and the conditions governing the free access to these services are set forth in BAGER, section 33.

5 INSTRUCTIONAL SERVICES AND PROGRAMS OF STUDY

In adult education centres, the Literacy Services, Preparatory Services for Secondary Education and Secondary Cycle One Education Services are associated with Common Core Basic Education (CCBE).

Secondary Cycle Two Education Services, Vocational Training Preparation Services and Preparatory Services for Postsecondary Education are associated with Diversified Basic Education (DBE).

CCBE

CCBE programs of study aim to upgrade the competencies of adult learners, develop their autonomy in exercising their social roles and encourage their self-fulfillment on a personal, intellectual and cultural level.

DBE

DBE programs of study lead to a Secondary School Diploma, vocational training or postsecondary education. They are adaptations of the Secondary Cycle Two programs in general education in the youth sector and the competency is developed through the subjects in a program.

Items 5.1 to 5.10 present the educational services and the programs of study connected to each of them. The courses that compose the programs are listed in Schedules 1 and 2.

The new curriculum in Adult General Education requires special rooms to be set up for Science and Technology programs of study in the various adult education centres.

With regard to the Vocational Training Preparation Services, it is possible for a student enrolled in a vocational training program to concurrently acquire general education credits, including credits required to obtain a Secondary School Diploma (SSD). In 2012-2013, the budgetary rules provide for additional funding for this purpose for adults under 20 years of age.

The new Sociovocational Integration program of study has been sent to the school boards for approval. The course codes are listed in Schedule 1.

The Sociovocational Integration Services lead to two distinct certificates, namely the Training Certificate in Sociovocational Integration of Adults (TCSIA) and the Training Certificate in a Semiskilled Trade (TCST).

The provisional bridge allowing admission to vocational training remains in place for 2012-2013. The admission conditions are as follows: a Training Certificate in a Semiskilled Trade (TCST); successful completion of Secondary II in language of instruction, second language and mathematics. The programs in the Diploma of Vocational Studies (DVS) that are accessible through the provisional bridge are listed in Schedule V of the Information document on the services and programs of study provides under Vocational Training.

5.8 Francization

Allophone students enrolled in a French school board take the *Français, langue seconde* program of study under the LAN alphanumeric codes, while adults enrolled in an English school board take the French as a Second Language program of study under the FRE codes. This program of study is still in use. The *Échelle québécoise des niveaux de compétence en français des personnes immigrantes adultes* and the *Programme-cadre de français pour les personnes immigrantes adultes au Québec* were distributed to the school boards in March 2012. The new francization program of study will be sent to the school boards in 2012-2013 so that they may familiarize themselves with it.

6 **ORIENTATION SERVICES**

(Reference No.: BAGER, s.14)

Orientation services are designed to enable adults:

- 1° to establish a learning plan following reception and referral services, taking into account their personal and work experience and their goals
- 2° to explore the paths and resources available in order to carry out their learning plan in keeping with their learning profile

7 **STUDENT SERVICES**

(Reference BAGER, s. 17-18)

Student services support the creation of conditions that encourage adults to stay in school and successfully complete their learning plan.

They include the activities below that enable adults to do the following:

Learning Support

Develop their strengths to find ways to overcome learning difficulties related to a handicap or other condition; examples of services: adaptations, compensatory study strategies

Training Support

Move forward in a stimulating environment that fosters their commitment to their learning plan; examples of services: student life services, cultural field trips or sports activities.

Counselling and Prevention

Adopt healthy lifestyle habits; improve their interpersonal relationships, attitudes; receive support in managing certain life situations; examples of services: seminars on balancing work-study-family, information related to alcohol or drug abuse, referrals in the case of health problems, etc.

Since 2007-2008, the budgetary rules have provided for specific funding to improve access to student services for all adults in general education. The financing of student services is part of the basic allowance under the provisions entitled *Ressources de soutien* (RS) and *Aide additionnelle pour les élèves ayant des besoins particuliers*. The specific funding for professional and support resources for students who are 16 to 18 years of age at AGE is included in this basic allowance.

8 EVALUATION OF LEARNING AND CERTIFICATION OF STUDIES

8.1 Evaluation of learning

The administrative procedures applicable to the evaluation of learning and the certification of studies are described in the *Administrative Guide for the Certification of Studies and Management of Ministerial Examinations (2011 edition)*, available on the Web site of the Direction de la sanction des études.

8.2 Certification of Secondary Studies

Section 30 of the *Basic Adult General Education Regulation* describes the certification requirements in force since July 1, 2010.

The results of evaluations to support learning, of diagnostic examinations and of placement tests do not count towards the certification of studies. The Policy on the Evaluation of Learning aims to consolidate and standardize evaluation orientations.

The Direction de l'enseignement collégial and the Direction de la sanction des études have issued a document providing further information on the procedures for applying the general requirements that devolve from the application, since July 1, 2010, of the certification rules pertaining to adult general education (Reference No.: *Info/Sanction*, no.10-11-021, 2011-02-16).

8.3 Official documents issued by the Minister

The Minister issues the following official documents to adults:

- a Secondary School Diploma (SSD)
- an achievement record that includes the results from secondary school and is printed in accordance with the publication calendar of the Charlemagne system
- an Attestation of Equivalence of Secondary Studies (AESS)
- a Training Certificate in Sociovocational Integration for Adults (TCSIA) issued by the Minister on the recommendation of the school board (*Info/Sanction* no. 564, 2008-04-21)
- a Training Certificate in a Semiskilled Trade (TCST) issued by the Minister on the recommendation of the school board (*Info/Sanction* no. 08-09-027, 2009-03-02; *Info/Sanction* no. 564, 2008-04-21)

With regard to the general education component, adults may complete the practical training only if they have already completed the required 450 hours of general education or demonstrate their ability to read, understand and write simple texts in the language of instruction, perform basic mathematical operations, and know and understand, in their second language, the terminology specific to their chosen semiskilled trade and to occupational health and safety. Sample tasks are provided in Schedule 3, Tasks Related to the Level Required to Practise a Semiskilled Trade.

It is strongly recommended, however, that adults continue their general education to strengthen their basic education.

With regard to the practical training, a minimum of 450 hours is required and is apportioned as follows:

- The 75 hours of preparation for the job market are spent in courses in the Sociovocational Integration program, in accordance with the adult's needs, with a view to selecting a trade, encouraging integration or remaining in the work force and making the job search process effective.
- The 375 hours of training leading to a semiskilled trade are spent in courses related to the development of occupational competencies. These hours should be spent primarily in practicums in host companies and lead to the mastery of the specific competencies in the semiskilled trade the student has selected.

8.4 Transmission of Results

School boards shall transmit an adult's results to the Minister upon request and in accordance with the Minister's requirements.

8.5 Duration of Training (Reference No.: BAGER, s. 31)

The duration of an adult's training is based on the number of credits required to complete his or her Adult General Education learning plan at the rate of 25 hours per credit.

During the training period, an adult is considered to be:

- enrolled on a full-time basis if he or she attends a minimum of 15 hours per week in general education
- enrolled on a part-time basis if she or she does not attend training in the same school board for more than 14 hours per week

However, as part of intensive training activities lasting less than one month, an adult enrolled on a part-time basis may attend training for a maximum of 30 hours per week.

It should be noted that the concepts of full-time and part-time identify the status of the adult student and have no impact on the declaration of enrollment procedure.
