THE DO'S AND DON'TS OF CYBERSPACE

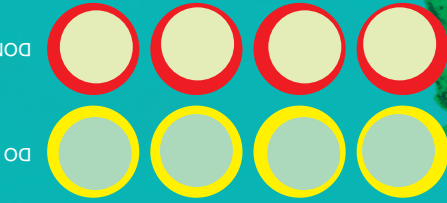
1 My passwords are like secrets... I don't tell them to anyone.
