

## IDEAS FOR FACILITATING CHILDREN'S GLOBAL DEVELOPMENT IN PRESCHOOL EDUCATION BETWEEN NOW AND THE END OF THE 2019-2020 SCHOOL YEAR

- 1 Consult the Preschool Education programs to identify their respective mandates.
- 2 Observe the children and gain an overall understanding of the learning they have acquired for each competency.
- 3 First, target the children's needs in the different areas of development.
- 4 In the program for 5-year-olds, identify the end-of-program expectations for each competency.

Your objective should be to ensure that, at the end of the current school year, the children:

- have had an opportunity to acquire learning in all five areas of development: physical and motor, emotional, social, language and cognitive
- have had opportunities to develop their full potential with regard to the

- you have the **AUTHORITY** and **PROFESSIONAL SKILLS** required to:
  - o determine the children's needs
  - o select the means to set up appropriate strategies to meet their needs in the current context
- you are in the **BEST POSITION** to determine the needs and interests of the different children in your class

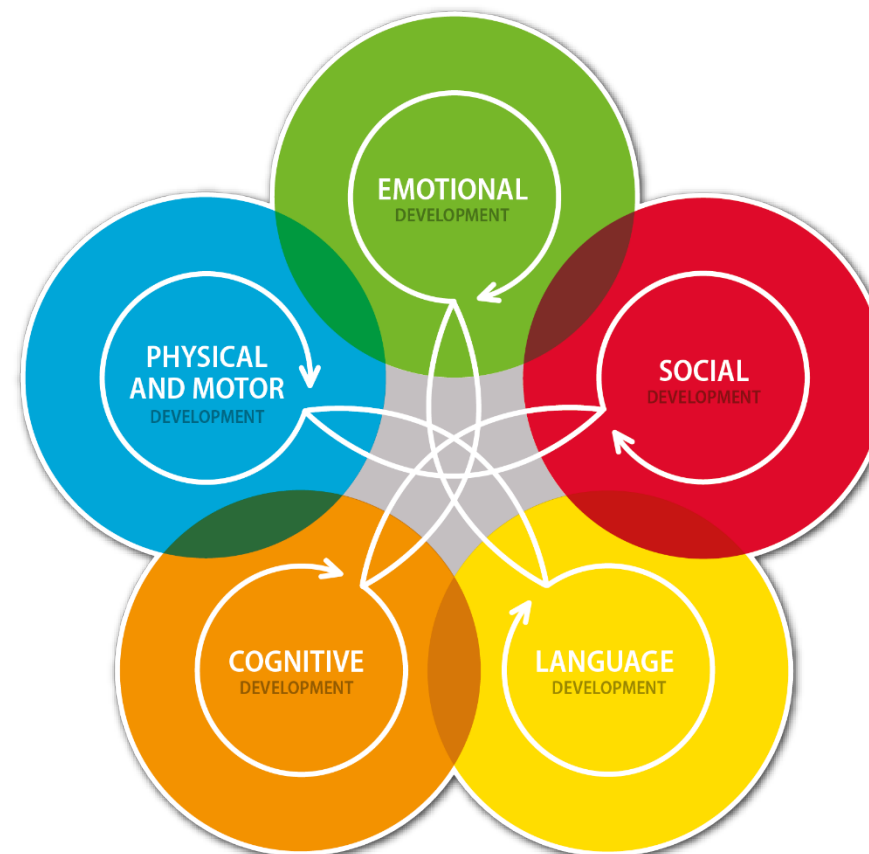
