## RELANCE SURVEY OF UNIVERSITY GRADUATES 2021

EMPLOYMENT SITUATION

OF GRADUATES

2017/2019/2021 Surveys









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### INTRODUCTION

The data presented here are based on the results of the *Relance survey of university graduates*, conducted every two years by the Ministère de l'Enseignement supérieur (MES).

The purpose of the 2021 survey is to provide a picture of the situation of 2019 graduates with a bachelor's or master's degree approximately 20 months after graduation. The survey meets a need for accurate and up-to-date information on how well recent university graduates are faring on the job market. Results are also presented for the surveys conducted on the situation of 2017 and 2015 graduates, respectively.

### **HIGHLIGHTS**

Situation during the week of january 17 to 23, 2021, approximately 20 months after obtaining a university degree:

#### **HOLDERS OF A BACHELOR'S DEGREE**

- The data from the survey indicate that 68.7% were employed, 26.1% were studying, 2.6% were seeking employment and 2.6% were considered inactive.
- Among employed graduates, 81.2% were working in their field of study. 92.5% of these graduates were working full-time and 7.5% were working part-time.
- The unemployment rate for holders of a bachelor's degree was 3.7%
- Among those studying in January 2021, 59.8% were pursuing their courses entirely through distance education, mainly due to the health crisis related to COVID-19.
- If they could redo their training, 86.8% of holders of a bachelor's degree would choose to attend the same educational institution and 68.6% would choose to enrol in the same program. These proportions may, however, vary significantly, depending on the discipline.

#### HOLDERS OF A MASTER'S DEGREE

- The data from the survey indicate that 82.6% were employed, 12.2% were studying, 2.7% were seeking employment and 2.4% were considered inactive.
- Among employed graduates, 84.7% were working in their field of study. 93.3% of these graduates were working full-time and 6.7% were working part-time.
- The unemployment rate for holders of a master's degree was 3.2%
- Among those studying in January 2021, 61.6% were pursuing their courses entirely through distance education, mainly due to the health crisis related to COVID-19.
- If they could redo their training, 89.0% of holders of a master's degree would choose to attend the same educational institution and 75.7% would choose to enrol in the same program. These proportions may, however, vary significantly, depending on the discipline.

The following table presents the variations in the rates observed between the 2021 and 2019 surveys. These variations are measured in percentage points (pts):

# GLOSSARY OF THE MAIN TERMS USED IN THE TABLES

#### Average age of graduates

Refers to their average age on july 1, 2019.

#### **Average hourly salary**

Refers to the average hourly salary earned by graduates in a normal work week. It is calculated based only on graduates who work for an employer and have stated that their job is related to their field of study.

#### **Employed**

Refers to target graduates who stated they were self-employed or working for an employer, and not studying full-time.

#### **Full-time**

Refers to graduates who are generally working at least 30 hours a week in a job related to their field of study, whether as selfemployed or working for an employer.

#### **Inactive**

Refers to target graduates who stated they were not employed, were not seeking employment and were not studying.

#### Job satisfaction

Refers to the proportion of graduates holding a paid-employment position related to their field of study who have rated their level of satisfaction with their job as equal to or higher than 8 on a scale from 1 to 10.

#### **Part-time**

Refers to graduates who are generally working less than 30 hours a week in a job related to their field of study, whether as self-employed or working for an employer. The proportion of graduates working part-time is obtained by subtracting the proportion of graduates working full time from 100% of all working graduates.

#### **Permanent employment**

Refers to a paid-employment position held by a graduate for which there is no indication that it will end on a determined date. This proportion is calculated based only on graduates holding a paid-employment position related to their field of study.

#### Reference weeks

The data are grouped according to the following reference weeks: january 17 to 23, 2021; january 20 to 26, 2019; and january 15 to 21, 2017.

#### **Response rate**

Refers to the number of target graduates who answered the questionnaire as a percentage of the total number of target graduates surveyed.

#### Seeking employment

Refers to target graduates who stated that they were actively looking for a job and were neither studying nor working.

## GLOSSARY OF THE MAIN TERMS USED IN THE TABLES (CONTINUED)

#### **Studying**

Refers to target graduates who stated that they were either studying full-time or part-time, and were not working.

#### Studying in related field

Refers to graduates who are studying and who stated that their current studies are in a field related to the degree they earned.

#### **Target graduates**

Refers to all holders of a bachelor's or master's degree targeted by the survey who received their degree during the calendar year two years prior to the year of the survey.

#### **Unemployment rate**

Refers to the number of graduates seeking employment expressed as a percentage of the labour force (which includes only those who are employed and those who are seeking employment).

#### Working in related field

Refers to graduates who are working, whether self-employed or for an employer, and who consider their job to be fully or partially related to their field of study.

### HOW INDICATORS ARE CALCULATED

The calculation table below uses data collected on holders of bachelor's degrees from the 2021 Relance survey of university graduates to illustrate how the main terms are used in the tables. The proportions of the four main situations (employed, seeking employment, studying, inactive) can be added together and total 100% of the respondents, as do the proportions for full-time and part-time work.
