INTRODUCTION

The data presented here are based on the results of the Relance survey of university graduates, conducted every two years by the Ministère de l'Enseignement supérieur (MES).

The purpose of the 2019 survey is to provide a picture of the situation of 2017 graduates with a bachelor's or master's degree approximately 20 months after graduation. It meets a need for accurate and up-to-date information on how well recent university graduates are faring on the job market. Results are also presented for the surveys conducted on the situation of 2015 and 2013 graduates, respectively.

HIGHLIGHTS

Situation during the week of january 20 to 26, 2019, approximately 20 months after graduation (see the table in the appendix):

Holders of a bachelor's degree:

- 69.8% were employed, 25.3% were studying, 2.2% were seeking employment and 2.7% were considered to be inactive.
- Among employed graduates, 80.3% were working in their field of study. 90.8% of these graduates were working full-time and 9.2% were working part-time.
- The unemployment rate was 3.0%. In 2015, the unemployment rate was under 5% for 41.6% of the disciplines (52 out of 125), while, in 2019, it was under 5% for 68% of the disciplines (85 out of 125).
- The proportion of disciplines in which 80% or more graduates held permanent jobs related to their field of study was higher in 2019 than in 2015, rising from 57 disciplines (47.9%) to 71 disciplines (60.2%).
- If they could redo their training, 81.8% of the graduates would choose to attend the same educational institution and 67.9% would choose to enrol in the same program. These proportions may vary significantly, depending on the discipline.

Holders of a master's degree:

- 82.4% were employed, 12.3% were studying, 2.5% were seeking employment and 2.8% were considered to be inactive.
- Among employed graduates, 82.9% were working in their field of study. 92.8% of these graduates were working full-time and 7.2% were working part-time.
- The unemployment rate was 3.0%, the same as that for holders of a bachelor's degree. In 2015, the unemployment rate was under 5% for 48% of the disciplines (60 out of 125), while, in 2019, it was under 5% for 70% of the disciplines (91 out of 130).
- The proportion of disciplines in which 80% or more graduates held permanent jobs related to their field of study was higher in 2019 than in 2015, rising from 46.2% to 56.5%.
- If they could redo their training, 81.7% of the graduates would choose to attend the same educational institution and 71.6% would choose to enrol in the same program. These proportions may vary significantly, depending on the discipline.

GLOSSARY OF THE MAIN TERMS USED IN THE TABLES

TARGET GRADUATES

Refers to all holders of a bachelor's or master's degree targeted by the survey who received their degree during the calendar year two years prior to the year of the survey.

RESPONSE RATE

Refers to the number of target graduates who answered the questionnaire as a percentage of the total number of target graduates surveyed.

AVERAGE AGE OF GRADUATES

Refers to their average age on July 1, 2017.

EMPLOYED

Refers to target graduates who stated they were self-employed or working for an employer, and not studying full-time.

SEEKING EMPLOYMENT

Refers to target graduates who stated that they were actively looking for a job and were neither studying nor working.

INACTIVE

Refers to target graduates who stated that they were not employed, were not seeking employment and were not studying.

STUDYING

Refers to target graduates who stated that they were either studying full-time or part-time, and were not working.

STUDYING IN RELATED FIELD

Refers to graduates who are studying and who stated that their current studies are in a field related to the degree they earned.

WORKING IN RELATED FIELD

Refers to graduates who are working, whether self-employed or for an employer, and who consider their job to be fully or partially related to their field of study.

FULL-TIME

Refers to graduates who are generally working at least 30 hours a week in a job related to their field of study, whether as self-employed or working for an employer.

PART-TIME

Refers to graduates who are generally working less than 30 hours a week in a job related to their field of study, whether as self-employed or working for an employer. The proportion of graduates working part-time is obtained by subtracting the proportion of graduates working full time from 100% of all working graduates.

PERMANENT EMPLOYMENT

Refers to a paid-employment position held by a graduate for which there is no indication that it will end on a determined date. This proportion is calculated based only on graduates holding a paid-employment position related to their field of study.

JOB SATISFACTION

Refers to the proportion of graduates holding a paid-employment position related to their field of study who have rated their level of satisfaction with their job as equal to or higher than 8 on a scale from 1 to 10.

AVERAGE HOURLY SALARY

Refers to the average hourly salary earned by graduates in a normal work week. It is calculated based only on graduates who work for an employer and have stated that their job is related to their field of study.

UNEMPLOYMENT RATE

Refers to the percentage ratio between the number of graduates seeking employment and the number of people in the labour force as a whole (which consists solely of people who are employed and people who are seeking employment).

REFERENCE WEEKS

The data are grouped according to the following reference weeks: January 20 to 26, 2019; January 15 to 21, 2017; and January 18 to 24, 2015.

HOW INDICATORS ARE CALCULATED

The calculation table below uses data collected on holders of bachelor's degree from the 2019 *Relance* survey of university graduates to illustrate how the main terms are used in the tables.

The proportions of the four main situations (employed, seeking employment, studying, inactive) can be added together and total 100% of the respondents, as do the proportions for full-time and part-time work.
