- * Encourage the children to play outside and to build forts, and remind them of the characteristics of a safe fort.

- 💥 Give the students original ideas for outdoor activities. Be creative!
- Ӿ Add to the "active homework" by organizing challenges between classes or with other schools.
- \bigstar Set aside time for the students to discuss their experiences and share ideas with each other.
